The candidate, if a clinician, must have at least 3 years of clinical experience, board certified, and hold a current state license. The candidate must exhibit exemplary communication, organizational, and teamwork skills.

The full-time tenure track faculty will work together with the program director and the other faculty members in advancing the education of the PAS Students in the fields of pediatrics, women's health, surgery, internal medicine and infectious diseases. New Faculty will help in didactic classroom, small group, laboratory teaching, and assisting with clinical education as well as additional responsibilities such as student research, scholarly activity, and service within the program, College, and University.
